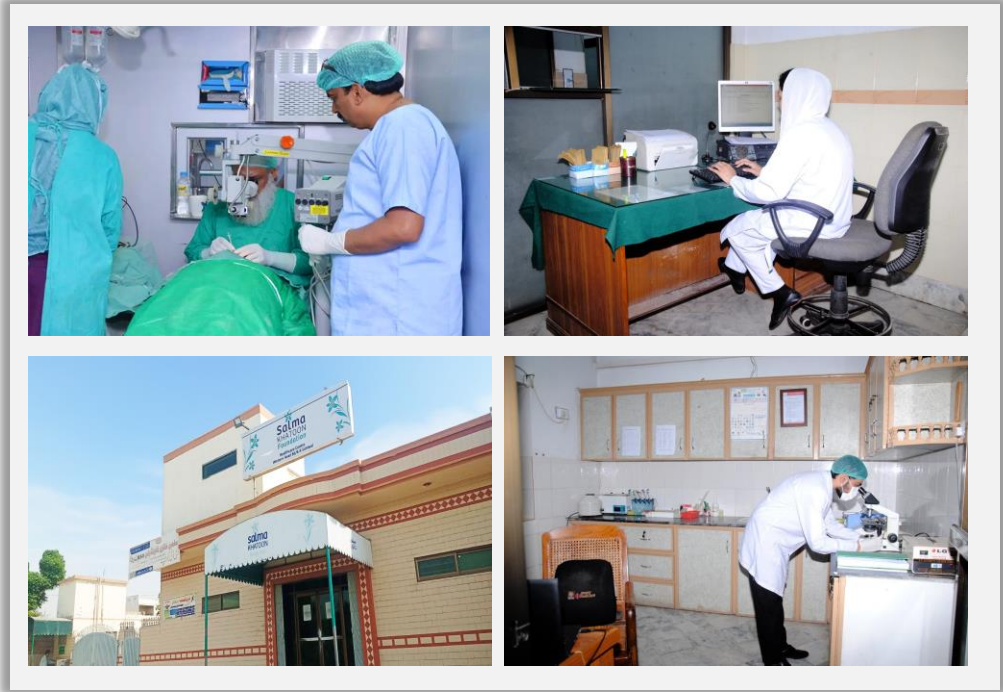

Salma Khatoon Healthcare Center

The Salma Khatoon Foundation's objective is to enhance the health of our communities through the provision of superior preventive care. Each year, we treat over 30,000+ patients at a minimal cost (560 PKR/USD \$2) and offer free services to those unable to pay the nominal fee. This fee encompasses medical consultation, laboratory tests, and medications provided by accredited doctors.



Preventive Healthcare

“Prevention is better than cure”.

Preventive healthcare consists of measures taken for disease prevention. Diseases are affected by environmental factors, genetic predisposition, disease agents, and lifestyle choices.



Doctor's Prescription & Medicines

Staffed by 4 fulltime highly qualified doctors and 12 nurses and supporting staff members, the hospital is a source of relief for the local members of the community. Our certified doctors give qualified medical advice on various health issues and help identify next steps which may include further tests, a prescription or lifestyle tips.



Diagnostic Lab

At **Salma Khatoon Foundation**, we provide state of the art lab testing facilities to the poor people of the area. Lab tests are performed by trained lab technicians with strict quality control. Currently, hundred of various blood and other diagnostic tests are being performed in our in-house lab facility.



Eye Camps

Salma Khatoon Foundation also offers free eye camps **four** times a year in collaboration with **Al-Ehsan Welfare Eye Hospital**. The eye camp consists of the latest equipment for a complete eye check-up, provides free glasses and performs free surgeries when needed. This year the team distributed more than **1,600** prescribed eyeglasses and performed over **250** successful eye surgeries.



Food Distribution

Salma Khatoon Foundation has distributed essential and nutritional food packages to deserving and underprivileged people in Sahiwal. Over the last three years, Pakistan's double-digit food price inflation, along with dwindling income, has left more Pakistanis food insecure. The World Food Program (WFP) estimates that approximately 43pc of Pakistanis are food insecure and 18pc of those have acute food insecurity.



Clean Water

Salma Khatoon Foundation has installed a free and clean water distribution plant for everyone to use in the community. More than 80 percent of the country's population faces "severe water scarcity." Especially poor population don't have access to clean water which becomes cause of many public health and general wellbeing issues.
